What is a Tool Kit for Eco Heroes?

Our tool kits are full of fun, with exciting things to do to inspire children to love and care for our environment. We want them to love the activities and their experiences be easy for you too.

Each Tool Kit will focus on a different theme and will include activities, news and information to connect children with our precious planet and inspire them to take action to protect it.

By including an easy crib sheet in each box, we hope to empower parents to start conversations with their children about specific environmental concerns. We want to make it easy for parents to include their children on the journey to greener living.

Our tool kits provide a fun and exciting eco-led gift that educates and gives back.

What age children are they aimed at?

Our Tool Kits are designed for aged 4 to 10 year olds. All the activities have easy instructions, but many will need some adult supervision. Any activities that require a grown up to help out, because extra care is needed are marked with a warning symbol. ⚠

What will you get in the box?

Each Tool Kit is themed around a specific environmental issue or an endangered animal. In a typical box, you would expect to find a poster or large sheet activity plus a smaller sheet activity, four activity cards (which may include arts and crafts, science experiments, gardening or messy play), a recipe card, an eco hero card, a collectable card, an I-Spy card and also something for grown ups. Each Tool Kit contains many hours of activities to keep your little eco hero busy!

What extra stuff will I need to buy?

One of the key ideas behind our Tool Kits is that we wouldn't bombard you with more 'stuff' each month. So most of the activities use things that you can find around your home, in your garden or even in the recycling box.

There are a few basics that will be needed each month, including scissors, glue, tape and colouring pencils.

Are your tool kits eco friendly?

Our Tool Kits are 100% sustainable and plastic free. All of the contents of our Tool Kits are printed on 100% recycled paper or card and printed using 100% vegetable inks.

We use a local Brighton based printer, that source all of their materials from UK or EU suppliers. They are Woodland Carbon accredited and support the Woodland Trust. The packaging we use is plastic-free, recyclable, biodegradable and made from sustainable materials.

How do you 'give back'?

As a social enterprise, we commit to giving 50% of our profits back to good causes and are proud to support conservation charity, the Born Free Foundation who are protecting the animals that our children love.

When will I receive my first tool kit?

If you purchase a one-off Tool Kit, you will receive it within a few days. If you have purchased a subscription, the first box will be sent out immediately and then subsequent tool kits will be dispatched every 2 months for the duration of your subscription. Release dates as follows: July, September, November, January, March, May.
